

Litter / Nuisance Enforcement Program

The Litter / Nuisance Enforcement program is the City of Oakland's investigative arm in the fight against illegal dumping and blight. The program investigates illegal dumping and blight problems on public property.

Illegal dumpers and haulers are prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law. It is critical that you know the legal way to handle your discarded materials.

If you witness materials being illegally dumped or discarded onto public property, place a call to the Public Works Agency's Call Center at (510) 615-5566. Please be prepared to provide information to the dispatcher, such as license plate number and description of vehicle.

For Vehicles and/or Debris and Blight on Private Property:

For tagging or towing of vehicles illegally parked on private property, call the Oakland Police Department at (510) 238-6040.

To investigate debris and blight on private property, call the Community and Economic Development Agency's blight hotline at (510) 238-3381.
